- Monitor symptoms and if your child is unwell please let them rest and recover. If you are concerned you should call your GP, the NSW Health COVID-19 Care at Home Support Line on 1800 960 933 or the National Coronavirus Helpline on 1800 020 080. If symptoms become severe call 000.

• If your child has a sore throat, runny nose, cough or shortness of breath after 7 days, please remain in isolation until 24 hours after symptoms have resolved.

• It is recommended that students who return to school after recovering from COVID-19 do not participate in rapid antigen test surveillance for 28 days (four weeks after recovery) following release from self-isolation.
