Students should wear their normal school uniform on parade day.

In order to comply with Covid regulations for school events, **a limited number of parents will be able to attend the parade**. Unfortunately, the space can accommodate 90 adult visitors only. K-2 parents that would like to attend the parade are asked to complete and return the expression of interest below. We will then randomly select parents/carers to attend the parade and only one adult from these families will be able to attend.
