Dear Parents and Carers,

The 2021 school photos will take place this coming Thursday 11 March, by our new school photographers, *Advanced Life*.

Earlier in the term, you should have received an envelope for your child/children. Advanced Life prefer that ordering be completed online, to reduce administration and potential security issues related to the return of cash and envelopes on photo day.

Orders for packages and sibling photographs can be placed securely online at <u>www.advancedlife.com.au</u> using our school's unique 9-digit advanced order code: **2HA W7P X74.** 

Portrait and group package orders are due by photography day, this Thursday.

If you would like to purchase a sibling photograph online, the order must be placed <u>no later</u> than **tomorrow**. Sibling photographs will only be taken if an order has been placed.

On photo day, sibling photos will begin at approximately 8:30am for students with last names starting with letters A through to K. Students will be called over the loud speaker when the photographers are ready to begin. Should we get through these photos quickly, more students will be called. No parents are to enter the hall during these photo times.

The remaining sibling photos (L-Z last names) will take place at 1:10pm (lunch time) and any remaining photos will be taken at the end of the school day, if needed.

If your children are having sibling photos, please ensue all children are aware. Older siblings will gather the younger children to the hall. All children need to listen carefully for announcements throughout the day, as there is no opportunity to make up photos on another day.

## Please remember to make payments and ensure students have all necessary parts of their summer school uniform in preparation for photo day.

If your child has not received a school photo envelope, they can be collected from the office.
