Mobile Phone and Device Agreement

Dear Parents/Carers

Electronic devices such as mobile phones, smart watches and fitness tracking devices are becoming more accessible and students are now bringing these items to school.

Your child may either be currently bringing, or may in the future bring, mobile phones and/or smart devices to school that connect to the internet. Oakhill Drive Public School requests that all parents and students agree to the following principles:

- Parents and students have responsibility for mobile devices in the event that they may get lost, damaged or stolen. The school takes no responsibility for mobile phones and devices.
- Mobile phones are to be switched off at all times during the school day, including recess and lunch breaks.
- Mobile phones are to remain in school bags at all times.
- Devices that can connect to the internet, make or receive messages, including email and SMS messages must be disabled at all times during the school day (8:30am – 3:00pm).
- Cameras in mobile phones and devices are not to be used at school. Mobile phones and devices are not to be used to record (audio or visual) or photograph (still or video).
- Parents wishing to contact their children during the day must do so by contacting the school office.
